
2025 LAI Gathering, Montreal Canada – Options for an Extended Stay for 3 to 6 days

Option 1: Montreal to Malbaie, Quebec by Train – 5-6 days

OPTION 1: Montreal to Malbaie, Quebec via Quebec City, by Train

Recommended Trip Duration: 5-6 days

(Total Distance one-way 396 km or 246 miles – Total Distance from Montreal to Quebec City one-way, 250 km or 155 miles)

Via Rail from Montreal to Quebec City, then take the train from Quebec City to La Malbaie

Day 1 and 2 – Montreal to Quebec City by Car or Rail

Day 3 - Baie St. Paul -

Population approx. 8,000

Located about 1 hour northeast of Quebec City the natural beauty of this Town has inspired countless artists, photographers and writers. The Town has a charming downtown and makes a perfect stop for a night "en route" to your final destination (Tadoussac) located approx. 2 hours further northeast along the St. Lawrence River.

A drive to Baie St. Paul is worth it just to experience the beauty of the Quebec countryside and St. Lawrence river north of Quebec City. Just north of Quebec City the St. Lawrence River widens dramatically and the views are spectacular as you travel north into a region known as Le Charlevoix.

Located 40 minutes northeast of Baie St. Paul. This hotel is also a good option for a one-night stay enroute to Tadoussac, Quebec. If you are looking for a luxury experience, a recommendation would be to spend the day in Baie St. Paul and then spend the late afternoon/evening relaxing at this historic hotel.

Day 4 and 5 - Tadoussac, Quebec – Population – 800

Tadoussac is a small historic town located approximately 3 hours northeast of Quebec City, located along the St. Lawrence River at the mouth of the Saguenay river. This region of Quebec is naturally stunning and steeped in French Canadian History going back to 1534 when Jacque Cartier travelled up the Saguenay Fjord searching for a passage to India. This Town would later

become a key port for Samuel de Champlain during his numerous voyages to Quebec

over 400 years ago.

If you are looking to learn more about French Canadian history and/or love nature, a short stop at this Town for two days is highly recommended. The Estuary and Gulf of St. Lawrence (EGSL) represents one of the largest and most productive estuarine/marine ecosystems in Canada and in the world. For its small size, Tadoussac offers a number of options for dining-and some good options for accommodations.


Day 6 - Return to Montreal for flight home –
