












# Welcome Presentation + The Economics of Los Angeles and California

The second day of the LA LEW began with breakfast at the Millennium Biltmore Hotel, in the Emerald Room. **Karin Chao** welcomed everyone to the first full day of events and introduced **Stephen Cheung** to the podium.

Stephen Cheung, representing the Los Angeles Economic Development Corporation, gave a presentation on Los Angeles County and Southern California as an economic powerhouse and the many industries, in addition to film, that drive the local economy. He highlighted the relationship of Los Angeles County's dense population to other parts of the United States and world and recognized the high number of small businesses that call this city and county home. He reiterated that Los Angeles has a lot of space for any type of business and investment.


Dr. Chris Thornberg of Beacon Economics gave a riveting Economic Forecast, focusing on real estate and the housing crisis from undersupply and overdemand, not only on a local level but across the state of California and extending across the country. Both speakers eloquently, and poignantly, touched on many of the topics we explored throughout the weekend.

### SoFi Stadium + Film Studio Tours

After wrapping up the morning presentations, we boarded 3 coach busses and headed to Inglewood for a Dine and Tour of SoFi Stadium. We began with a delicious early lunch and a presentation from Mayor James Butts, Jr., the esteemed leader who brought SoFi Stadium, and numerous other projects, to the City of Inglewood.

This was followed by an incredible in-depth presentation on the design and revolutionary construction of the stadium by Turner and AECOM HUNT teams, **Craig Bojda, Michael Marchesano** and **Juresha Alemayehu**. From there we toured the 70,000 seat sports and entertainment complex, home of the Los Angeles Chargers and Los Angeles Rams, winners of Super Bowl LVI. We were invited to run through the tunnel as if we were players on either team and explore the locker rooms and field perimeter.


















## Taco Night in West Hollywood




